#### MESSAGE FROM MSGR. TUCKER

Dear Parishioners.

September 27<sup>th</sup> is the feast day of St. Vincent de Paul. In a parish under his patronage, it is a Solemn feast day. It would be a good day to attend Mass, and it is also a day to celebrate. If you have the habit of abstaining from meat on Friday, you do not need to do that this Friday on his feast day. It is also a good time to think about his life and try to imitate him.

- St. Vincent obviously had some honorable traits worthy of imitation. The first is that he recognized his own imperfections and the importance of relying on God to help him change.
- St. Vincent realized he was embarrassed that he came from a poor family and rejected his own father. He humbly asked for forgiveness from his father and reconciled with his family. He recognized the goodness in the poor and spent his life serving the needs of others. He brought parish members with financial resources to help the poor together to help those in need.

His bishop asked him to help form newly ordained priests, so he instructed them and brought them together to pray. His example reminds us of the importance of praying for priests. He also formed the religious order "The Daughters of Charity", so it is also a good reminder to pray for the religious sisters in our Diocese and in the country.

There were so many things that St. Vincent did in his lifetime. It seems impossible for one person to do so many things, but He reminds us that all things are possible with God's help. If you are feeling overwhelmed with all the things that you have to do, ask St. Vincent to pray for divine assistance in your work. God Bless you, and I hope you have a good day on Friday, that is the date of our patron's feast.
