MESSAGE FROM MSGR. TUCKER

Dear Parishioners,

October 7th is the one-year anniversary of the conflict in Israel, and as you may be following the war in Middle East, you know that it has spread to Lebanon and Iran. Pope Francis is asking for us to pray and fast on Monday for peace in the Middle East. As you know there are conflicts in other parts of the world too. We should be praying and fasting for peace often, but we can join other Catholics around the world in this effort for peace. We should remember the instruction given to the apostles from Jesus when they were unable to cast out demons. Jesus told them that prayer and fasting is needed to cast out certain demons. I'm not referring to those involved in these conflicts as demons, but I am reminding all of us that fasting and prayer and very powerful in effecting change.

I pray often for conversion of hearts. I pray that all may know God's love, and I ask that His love may change hearts. A heart that knows true love, will want others to know that which will change the way that we respond to others. I was reading from the classic book "The Devout Life" and in it there is a chapter on humility and anger. St. Francis de Sales states that we can judge our level of humility when we are confronted with conflict. We may think that we are humble and meek, but when conflict comes along, we respond with anger. He states that Augustine refers to anger as bringing an army into the fight. He says that the truly humble person responds to conflict with patience, kindness and love, and doesn't bring the army to fight it, which includes everything that comes along with the emotion of anger. There is much more to this address from St. Francis de Sales, but it was a good reminder to me, and hopefully to all that we are called to respond to one another in humble service, clothed with kindness, patience and love. God Bless you.
