MESSAGE FROM MSGR. TUCKER

Dear Parishioners,

Many people are already voting, so I want to write a few things about initiatives 439 and 434, and the referendum 435. All of these bills are causing some confusion and there are many adds presenting differing messages about these.

On Thursday a parishioner brought a postcard that encouraged people to vote against both 439 and 434. This postcard is coming from a strong Pro-Life group that believes that 434 does not go far enough to restrict abortions. The Nebraska Catholic Conference is encouraging us to vote against 439 and to vote for 434. Their understanding of the language in 439 is that it will overturn all of the good pro-life bills that our Legislature has work for over the past 50 years. They believe that 439 will open the door to abortions during the entire term of pregnancy. They also believe that the language of 434 will keep the pro-life bills and the restrictions of abortions where they are currently in the state. Voting for 434 will keep the status quo. As Catholics we have a grave responsibility to protect life and to help support mothers that have an unplanned pregnancy. The situation of a pregnancy that is endangering the life of the mother does not fall under the title of abortion because of a principle called "double effect". In this situation the action done to save the life of the mother has the unwanted consequence of the death of the child. The death of the child is not willed, rather saving the life of the mother is willed. Since this is saving life, and allowing an unwanted consequence, it is not referred to as an abortion, according to Catholic Moral teaching.

The referendum 435 is also generically referred to as the school bill. In May I was at the Legislature for the final hearing of the bill. It was very interesting to listen to the State Senators debate the bill and their reasoning for the support of allocating ten million dollars for scholarships for families that desire a private education for their children. These are families that cannot afford a private school, and are choosing it for many reasons, and hoping to give their child an education that will them rise above their life of poverty. The Governor has allocated this money for these scholarships and has not decreased the money available for public schools. Voting to retain 435 will help families in need to provide for the educational needs of their children.

I hope that this will help you as you go to vote. God Bless you.

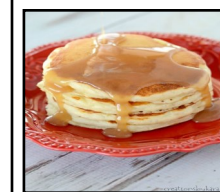
