## MESSAGE FROM MSGR. TUCKER


Dear Parishioners,

I made this announcement on Monday, and in case you did not hear it, I am presenting this in the bulletin, that we will soon begin a search for a new principal for the 2025-26 school year. Mrs. Denise Ray ( will be retiring after 31 years of Catholic education) and will continue to the end of this current school year. There will be a selection committee formed from parents, school staff and parish members. Fr. Stoley, the Diocesan Superintendent will also be a part of the process.

I am grateful for the blessings Mrs. Ray brought to St. Vincent's in her seven years, and those she will continue to share with our students and their families through the rest of this school year. I pray in gratitude for her work and ask the Lord's blessings on all her future endeavors. Please keep the search for a new principal in your prayers.


There is a lot to look forward to, with the initial success of our Gather and Grow campaign. We are at 40% of our goal, and I am pleased with the generous contributions, and the excitement that this has generated. There is a real need for a separate and dedicated area for the education of the children of the parish. I wish that the plan could include a gymnasium but that would add another \$3.4 million to the goal. The commons area will be twice as big as the area our school children are currently using as a gym, and I know it is not the same as a gym, but it will be better than what we currently have available for PE. The important focus in this campaign is that we are beginning to make changes, and we need to continue this attitude. Each step forward makes the whole better, even if the steps seem small. Again, I thank you for your support of the Gather and Grow campaign and I believe God is moving many hearts and great things are happening. God Bless you.
