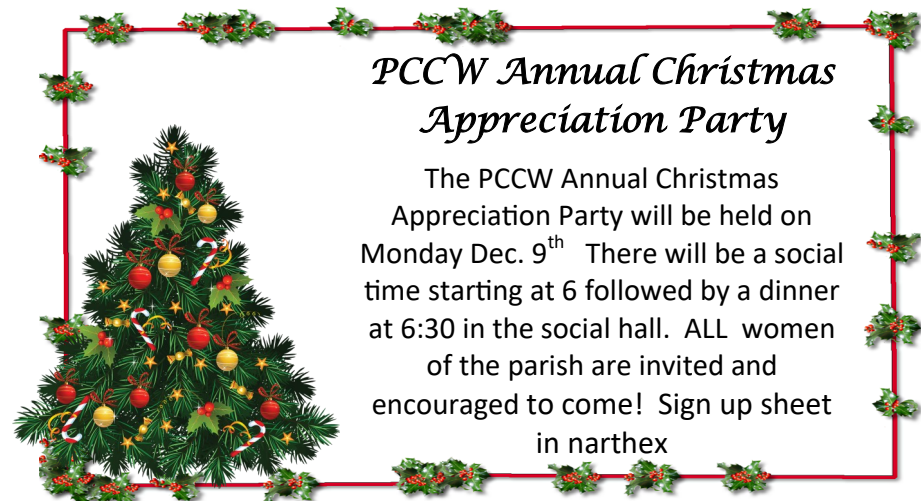
MESSAGE FROM MSGR. TUCKER

Dear Parishioners,

This week pledges to the Gather and Grow campaign went over the \$2.5 million mark from 105 pledges. This is great news, and I am grateful for the generous response to the request for support to the future of St. Vincent's. We still have a lot of work to do, and I believe there are still questions about the plan.

The question I heard this week is "why are we embarking on an effort that only benefits the school?" The majority of the money raised will go to the construction of a dedicated space for school, with classrooms and a commons area. The plan is much more than building classrooms. It is a plan for the future that will provide space for all parish activities. It will create useable spaces that will provide a good area for children and adults to grow in their faith, and to prepare for special family events, such as funerals and weddings. The plan will also provide good spaces for meetings and for adult education. The plan is focused on preparing for the future growth of Seward which is well on its way! The classrooms will be used primarily for school children, but they will provide a better space for CCD classes since the rooms will be larger and the walls will be permanent.

The goal to raise \$5.6 million for this campaign is more than St. Vincent's has ever raised before. We can celebrate the dollars pledged so far in this campaign. St. Vincent's has far surpassed the money raised in the Joy of the Gospel campaign which took place nearly 10 years ago. When I came here in 2017 and heard that \$1.3 million was raised for the Joy of Gospel campaign I was impressed. The members of the Finance Council have said over and over again that the people of St. Vincent's are very generous, and they respond to the needs of the parish and the Diocese. I firmly agree with that assessment, and I am convinced that it is true with our efforts so far with the Gather and Grow campaign. The Steier Group believes that we can reach the \$4 million mark, and I believe that we can do that and more! Thank you for your support, and let's continue working on this important plan for the future. God Bless you. -Msgr. Tucker
