Please note that the Immaculate Conception is a holy day of obligation. The Masses for the feast are Sunday evening at 7 pm, and Monday at 6:45 am, noon and 5 pm. Mary, under the title "Immaculate Conception", is the patroness for our country. The feast day is always obligatory regardless of the day of the week. Since the 8<sup>th</sup> is Sunday, the feast is moved to Monday because she is the patroness of our country. Please remember to pray for our government officials, for peace and justice, and for strong families in relationship with God.
