Dear Parishioners.

During this Advent season we have encouraged you to go to confession. The sacrament prepares our heart to receive Jesus on Christmas Day. It tidies up the soul, making it a welcome sight for Jesus to come in. If you have not been to confession in a long time do not worry. Fr. Hottovy and I welcome you to the sacrament and Jesus gives tremendous peace and joy as He forgives your sins. We have confessions every morning Monday through Friday beginning at 6:40 am (prior to the 7 am Mass). We also have confessions on Saturday from 4:30 to 5:30 pm (prior to evening Mass) and 30 minutes prior to the Sunday Masses. We will have our Penance Service on Sunday, December 22 at 5 pm and there will be 9 priests hearing confessions. Priests from the Seminary and the surrounding area are gracious enough to come and hear confessions. We will also have the sacrament available on Monday, December 23 from 5 until 7 pm. Please take the opportunity to make a good confession before Christmas!

This weekend we have our Gather and Grow commitment weekend. I am truly grateful for the hard work and the time and talent of parishioners that has helped us get to this point in the campaign. Over the last four months I have thought a lot about the reasons for this campaign and the direction the parish leaders are supporting in this effort. I am more and more convinced that this is the right direction for us as a parish.
