MESSAGE FROM MSGR. TUCKER

Dear Parishioners.

Merry Christmas! Fr. Hottovy and I will be remembering all in our Christmas Masses, as we will prayer for your particular intentions. The most important intention that I pray for is that our relationship with Jesus may grow each day. On Friday morning the reading was from Isaiah 7:10-14. It concludes with these words: "Therefore the Lord himself will give you this sign: the virgin shall conceive and bear a son and shall name him Emmanuel". A passage that reminds me of the depth of relationship God wants to have with us.

In the beginning of the passage Isaiah states that God spoke to Ahaz and told him to ask for a sign. Then Isaiah states that this is the sign that God will give, a child born of a virgin and he will be Emmanuel. Emmanuel is a word that means "God with us". God reveals Himself to us through His word, and also in His presence. This is key to a deeper relationship with God. It is not enough for us to hear His voice; He desires to be "God with us". God is with us from the moment of our baptism as He dwells within our soul. He wants us to grow in relationship with Him through the reception of Him in sacrament. The sacraments are a reception of Jesus, and this increases our life with God.

We are only nine days from the end of the year. The celebration of Christmas can be a very spiritual moment for us, and it is good to think about continuing that closeness to Him throughout the year. I encourage you to take some time over the last week of the year and think about how you can grow in your relationship with God. Consider how His word and His presence will help you in that goal. Think about how you can grow in your prayer life and hear His voice in the Scriptures and in your prayer. Also think about receiving communion more frequently and even daily.

This is my prayer for you. I pray that together we may grow in our relationship with God, who loves us so much that He is present in word and in sacrament. God Bless you. -Msgr. Tucker


Monetary Gifts
