MESSAGE FROM MSGR. TUCKER

Dear Parishioners,

As we begin this year, a common practice is to look back on the events of the previous year, and it is a time to be grateful. The key is to be grateful for everything, which is difficult. In the Christmas book, "Lift up your hearts", John Burns gives a good meditation on gratitude.

He writes, " Perhaps one of the greatest exercises we can ever undertake as a regular part of our spiritual regimen is to make a list of all we have received...Whatever gifts God gives to us are not solely for our private benefit. God gives us gifts to aid us in building up his Body and bringing about the ordering of this world to the kingdom. He bestows gifts upon us in order to aid us in strengthening, empowering, healing, and blessing the other parts of the Body that are in need or lacking such gifts...thanksgiving is not in view of building up a prideful disdain for those who have less but rather to empower us to see that we are blessed not accidentally but for a task, and that task is the building up of the Body of Christ...We ought to undertake this exercise often, and to conclude it by holding up all of our gifts before the Father's gaze. As we do, we should beg for the grace to always be worthy stewards and joyful recipients of his superabundance".

The most difficult part of gratitude is acknowledging that everything comes from God. The things we ask for, the things we don't ask for, and the things that are given and taken away. Mother Teresa used to say, "Take whatever He gives and whatever He takes with a big smile". God knows what is best for us, so let us receive with joy! God Bless you. -Msgr. Tucker

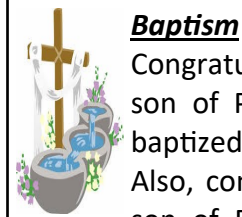
