MESSAGE FROM MSGR. TUCKER

Dear Parishioners.

We finish the Christmas season this weekend with the Baptism of Jesus and we then quickly enter into the Ordinary time of the liturgical year. There are 34 weeks of Ordinary time, and we have eight of these before we start the season of Lent on March 5th. The Ordinary time of the year focuses on living on faith after being inspired and encouraged by the extraordinary seasons of the year, such as Christmas, Lent and Easter. The longer portion of Ordinary time after Easter is a test in one sense, because it is easy to get distracted with other things and to quickly forget about the inspiration and direction we receive during Lent and Easter.

The book by Fr. John Burns, "Lift up your hearts" helps to direct our hearts toward God. It is particularly helpful during the Ordinary times of the year. When we want something to redirect us, or to encourage us to deepen our relationship with God, these meditations will help. This is a book that can be read multiple times during a year. The book should be read in 10 days, as there are that number of meditations. The original meditations from St. Frances de Sales are difficult to read and follow, but Fr. Burns has crafted these topics in a language easy to understand, which examples that make good sense. If you have not opened the book, I encourage you to do so and enter into a ten-day retreat. assure you that it will redirect your heart to God. You could then work through the meditations again during Lent, and then pick it up again in September, and I will bet you will find each session different and fruitful. God Bless you.
