MESSAGE FROM MSGR. TUCKER

Dear Parishioners,

Last week in our combined meeting with Parish and Finance Council we looked at our current total of pledges to the Gather and Grow campaign and talked about the future goals for our campaign. We still have a number of people to talk with that said during the planning study that they would like to contribute to the campaign, and we have not been able to connect with them. There are also nearly 300 parishioners that received a letter asking for a pledge to the campaign and there is a need to follow up with that group. We believe that there are other avenues to investigate, and putting this all together, we believe we can get close to a goal of \$4 million pledged.

The Diocesan requirement for beginning a building/renovation plan requires that we have half of the money for the project in our bank account, and the rest, plus 10% of the project pledged. The combined meeting last week was in agreement that we should meet with Clark Enersen, the Diocesan Building committee, and parish members and myself to take the next step with is sending out a proposal to contractors that the Diocese approves of to determine what we can do with \$4 million pledged. That meeting is scheduled for next Friday, and I have as parish representatives Mark Peery and Tim and Michelle Winkelman. The Diocese recommends selecting a contractor to work with the architects from the beginning. A base project would be determined, and then additional options would be included, and would be phased into the project as money is available. The hope is that we continue to raise money, and the project can proceed from the base project, right into options without any interruption. Please remember us in your prayers for this week, and as I have more information to share, I will do so. God Bless you.
