MESSAGE FROM MSGR. TUCKER

Dear Parishioners.

I had a baptism a couple of years ago, and the family of Rudy and Marie Codr told me that if we ever wanted to remodel the Marian niche in the Church, which was decorated in memory of Rudy and Marie and their family, that they would support that project. The facility committee and I have been working with Cheever construction to remodel that area. We selected Cheever because they did the work remodeling the front of the sanctuary. The plan is to have the same stone and design in the Marian niche, so that it looks similar to the niche where the tabernacle resides. The cost of this project will be covered by donations. The stone will take 6-8 weeks to arrive, and the statue of Mary will be moved to the side with the votive candles. We are looking for an artist to repair and repaint the statue of Mary.

We also are going to change the main confessional. According to Diocesan directives, we need a separate entrance into the confessional for the priest and the penitent. We will be putting a new door next to the current door. The current door will be for the penitent to enter, and the new door will be for the Pledge Payments priest. We will still have an option for face-to-face confession, but there will be a screen between the priest and the penitent that allows the penitent to be visible | Campaign. When making your arrangements to have to the priest.

These projects will be starting very soon, but it will be a couple of months before they are finished. They should be done by Easter. Please ask questions about these projects. You can ask me or any member of the Facility Committee. Thanks, and God Bless you. -Msgr. Tucker
