### **MESSAGE FROM MSGR TUCKER:**

Dear Parishioners,

You will notice this weekend that progress is being made on the new entrance to the confessional and on the niche for the Blessed Virgin Mary. The niche has a long way to go, since the stone we will use is being made by the same company that made the stone in the front of the Church. They will need at least 6-8 weeks to complete that area.

There are questions about the confessional and the reason for this change. The confessional should be operational next week, the reason for this change is due to the direction from the United States Catholic Conference of Bishops, and our Bishop's response to their direction.

The UCCB gave direction about the sacrament of confession to all Bishops in the United States at their fall meeting in 2023. Generally the UCCB describes access to confession in these terms: "The conference of bishops is to establish norms regarding the confessional; it is to take care, however, that there are always confessionals with a fixed grate between the penitent and the confessor in an open place so that the faithful who wish to can use them freely." In December 2023 our Bishop sent the following message to all parishes his interpretation of the directive from the UCCB. Bishop Conley's direction states, "I would like to draw your attention to one point in particular: the design of our confessionals. I am asking each parish to ensure that there is a permanent barrier between penitent and priest in all permanent confessionals within the Diocese of Lincoln."

I have been in conversation with a number of pastors in the Diocese and with Fr. Caleb LaRue, the Chancellor of the Diocese to determine what we should do with our confessional. The conclusion is what we are currently doing with the confessional. There will still be the opportunity to have a face-to-face confession, but it will be the choice of the penitent to do this by moving a screen back so as to see the priest, yet they will still be a screen between the priest and the penitent. As I have been using the old confession the last couple of weeks I again am reminded of blessings in this approach, and I believe you will experience that too with this new arrangement. It will take some time for us to get used to this change, but I believe it will have many benefits. God Bless you.

the volunteers to meet around 1:00 p.m. on Friday afternoon to help out. Thank you!






# Can You Help?
