## **MESSAGE FROM MSGR TUCKER:**

### Dear Parishioners,

I am grateful for the priests that came to speak this week for our Parish Mission. Each night was live streamed on Facebook, and they are still on Facebook. If you were not able to come to the Mission, you will be able to listen to them from our Facebook page. Each priest spoke about joy, and they are different in the way they spoke about joy in relationship to prayer, fasting and almsgiving. Each priest is different, and each talk is excellent.

I am also grateful for the number of confessions that we heard during the Mission. I believe there was a lot of grace flowing during the three days and that it was a true encounter with Jesus, and a reception of His abundant mercy and love.

We will have a Penance Service on Palm Sunday evening. Palm Sunday is on April 13<sup>th</sup> at 5 pm, and there will be between 7 and 9 priests here. Confession during the season of Lent unites us with the reason God came into this world. He came to offer His life on the cross for the forgiveness of our sins. A Lenten confession is an entrance into His saving love offered on the cross for us. I encourage everyone to take some time to examine their conscience before the Penance Service. If it has been a long time since your last confession you may begin by going through the ten commandments. If there has been any serious sin since your last confession, going through the commandments will help you call to mind those offenses. Most importantly remember, that beginning with an examination of conscience is saying "yes" to the invitation Jesus gives us to be united with Him. We begin there experiencing His mercy and love, and then with the forgiveness of sins it is real and then continues with the grace that He gives us in the sacrament that helps us stay free from sin.

Let us continue our Lenten practices as we are closing this Lenten season, and we are quickly approaching the celebration of Easter! God Bless you.
