MESSAGE FROM MSGR TUCKER:

Dear Parishioners,

This is the last full week of Lent, and then we move into the celebration of Holy Week. We still need help from servers, readers and acolytes for Holy Week, so look at the sign-up sheet for open slots where you can assist.

This year we have a great group of people that will make a profession of faith at the Easter Vigil and become Catholic. One in our group will be received into the Church at St. Patricks' in Utica, and there will be seven received here. Please keep them in your prayers as they prepare for entrance into the church.

We will have our Penance service next Sunday at 5 pm and we will have at least six priests available to hear confessions. This is a great opportunity to make a good confession prior to Easter. The older Catholics remember the term "Easter Duty". This is still the law of the Church, and it states that every Catholic is required to go to confession and receive communion at least once during the Lent and Easter season. That is a twelve-week period, but it makes the most sense to me, to go to confession before Easter. Jesus died for the forgiveness of sins, and then He rose to new life. When we go to confession, we die to sin, and through His forgiveness, we rise to new life with Him. I hope you can make it to the Penance Service, if you have not had the opportunity to go to confession during Lent. We will have confessions during Holy Week and that schedule will be in the bulletin. God Bless you.
