MESSAGE FROM MSGR TUCKER:

Dear Parishioners.

This week we enter into Holy Week, and it is a great opportunity to reflect on God's love for us. As John the Apostle wrote in the third chapter of his gospel, "God so loved the world, that He sent His Son". We need to personalize that this week and remember that the world includes each one of us. God loves me, so He sent His Son to save me!

I have been reading a book on "Eucharistic Mission" and this message is a foundational piece to the understanding of mission. To understand what God desires for us, and to understand His will for us, we need to begin with relationship with God. This week is a good time to read the first few chapters of the book of Genesis. The story tells of our creation and our relationship with God. It tells about the damage to that relationship through sin, and God's faithfulness and love through the promise of a savior. God was in relationship with Adam and Eve from the very beginning of their creation, and it is in that relationship they came to understand their identity. They knew who they were, so after their sin there was such great shame and guilt that they tried to hide from God. They knew God, they knew who they were created to be, so they knew His will for them and that is the mission they had for them.

We too are called to that sequence of experiences. We are called to be in relationship with God, and through our encounter with Him we understand our identity and then He sends us out on mission, which is doing His will. The Eucharist is the key to our relationship with Him. He comes to us, Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity, and we come to know who we are in relationship with Him. Then we are ready to be sent. He is relying on us, and He wants us to be in relationship with Him, because He wants His love to be known by all. We are His hands, feet and voice, and we can either help people to know Him, or we can lead people away from Him by

I hope these reflections give you plenty to think and pray about this week. I hope you have a blessed Holy Week. If you have not been to confession, there are plenty of opportunities this week, and be ready to receive Jesus this week and allow Him to send you to bring His love to all. God Bless you.


