

MESSAGE FROM MSGR TUCKER:

Dear Parishioners,

Happy Easter! Jesus is Risen, and may the risen Christ, fill you and your families with new life, and may your celebration of Easter bring great joy to your household. Fr. Hottovy and I have your prayer intentions in our hearts, and we are praying for His blessings for you.

Now we enter the Easter Season, and particularly this coming week, we celebrate the resurrection. The next eight days are called the Octave of Easter which means that the celebration of Easter Sunday continues for eight days. Each day until next Sunday should be a special and joyful celebration of Easter. If you could come to daily Mass, it would help to continue the celebration of Easter. If you are unable to attend daily Mass, I suggest that you take time each day to read one of the resurrection stories. The last part of each of the four gospels tells various stories of Jesus' time with the apostles from the time of the resurrection to the ascension. This is a great way to keep the resurrection in your mind each day. Jesus truly rose from the dead. It is a real event that is the most precious gift from the Father to us. Our Father's love is revealed to us perfectly in the life, passion, death and resurrection of Jesus. Reading the eyewitness accounts of these events in Jesus' life helps us realize this truth. The Father loves us, so He sent His Son. The Son loves us, so He chose the cross. The Father and Son's love is made manifest in the gift of the Holy Spirit who abides with us now, helping us to know the depth of God's love for us.

Again, Happy Easter, and now let us celebrate! God Bless you. Msgr. Tucker
