

#### **MESSAGE FROM MSGR TUCKER:**

Dear Parishioners.

This week with the death of Pope Francis, it changed the tenor of the Octave of Easter. The joy of the week was tempered a little with the death of the Holy Father. You will notice this weekend that the picture of Pope Francis is in front of the altar, with a black cloth behind it. This direction is given by the USCCB to place his picture in a prominent place with a black cloth behind it to help people mourn the loss of our Pope, but also as a reminder to pray for him. The novena that I sent out by Flocknote continues until Tuesday, even though his funeral was on Saturday.

The next series of prayers will be for the conclave. The date of the conclave has not yet been set, but the earliest starting date is fifteen days after the death of the Pope, which is May 5th. We believe that the Holy Spirit directs the Cardinals in the election of the Pope and we can assist them in their duty with our prayers. When I get the prayers from the USCCB I will again send them out by Flocknote.

This is an opportunity for you to sign up for Flocknote. You can call the Church office and the secretaries can assist you in that process. This is a platform of communication that is powerful, and can be customized to facilitate communication to the whole parish, or to individual groups in the parish. I know we are under utilizing this tool, and I am looking for ways to use it more effectively. God Bless you, and remember to pray for the children of the parish that are being confirmed this weekend by Bishop Bruskewitz.
