

#### **MESSAGE FROM MSGR TUCKER:**

Dear Parishioners,

When I talk to people about their prayer life, and even when I reflect on my own prayer life, I am made aware of what many spiritual directors refer to as times of consolation and desolation. There are people that say that during times of consolation that they are aware that God is present with them. The consolations can also be described as an awareness of God's blessings, and the joy or peace that is in their heart during this time of revelation. It is very easy to conclude that during times of desolation, when there is sadness or loss, fear or anxiety, that God is absent. That conclusion is far from the truth.

The book that I have been reading, "The Friendship of Christ", by Robert Hugh Benson, reflects very clearly and beautifully on our experiences of consolation and desolation. He does this in a reflection on the words of Jesus, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me", from the cross. His last sentence in his reflection is, "For in losing thee, I lose all", to which can be added, "for then I find there is nothing but God alone".

This is a great challenge for us, and it also an invitation to enter a great mystery, and deepen our friendship with Christ. St. Paul speaks of seeing Christ in all things. In all things that we are actively doing (i.e. the good that we do), and in every moment of every day, even in the quiet and silence and inactivity of the day. When we are able to see Christ in all things, and then when everything is taken away, we come to know in our heart that there is nothing accept God alone. This is a great mystery that is important for us to know, because it does two things. The first is that it helps us to understand that everything in this world is from God, and secondly that it sets our hearts on God alone preparing us for death and being united with God forever. Not to be morbid, but the reality is that we are taking nothing with us when we die. We need to reflect on where our hearts are with regards to the things of this world and the heavenly realm. The two are not separate, since everything has come from God, and knowing that, sets our hearts on Him alone.

I know this is a little heavy, but I encourage you to reflect on this, pray for the grace to see God in all things, deepening your friendship with Christ. God Bless you.
