MESSAGE FROM MSGR TUCKER:

Dear Parishioners,

February 18th is Ash Wednesday and the beginning of Lent. That is less than two weeks away! Before Beth Nemec finished her work we were talking about the Lenten season. We talked about getting information from Hallow about Lent, and we have done so. There will be a banner from them in the narthex and you will be able to scan their QR code and you will find an abundance of spiritual material for Lent.

There will also be a Lenten Mission this year. Chad Steiner from the Emmaus Institute will be here March 16th through the 18th. He will talk about learning to find Jesus in the Scriptures, using the resurrection story of Jesus on the road to Emmaus as the foundation. He will speak each evening and there will be time for adoration and confession. There will be more details coming soon, but mark these dates down in your calendar.

Also during Lent you can make commitment to pray more and you can simply stop in the Church on Monday or Wednesday during our hours of adoration (9 am until 6 am the following day). We will also have the Stations of the Cross every Friday and the times will be posted in the bulletin.

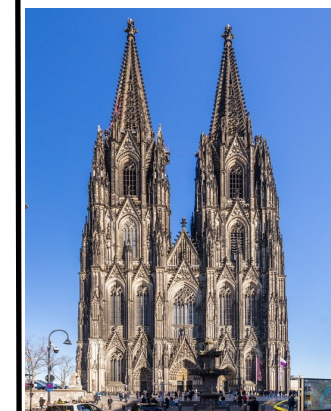
