MESSAGE FROM MSGR TUCKER:

Dear Parishioners,

This Memorial Day has added importance as the United States celebrates its 250th birthday. From the beginning of our nation justice, peace and faith have been its cornerstone. There have been many challenges over two and a half centuries, yet in faith and good will we have persevered. Our current challenges at home and abroad remind us the importance of our commitment to these guiding principles. As people of faith we understand that this gift is one that guides the other pieces necessary for a sound nation. As we also celebrate Pentecost this weekend we understand that faith, guided, informed and strengthened by the Holy Spirit, leads us to act justly and walk humbly with our God. 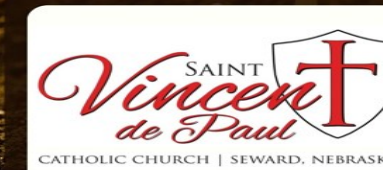
