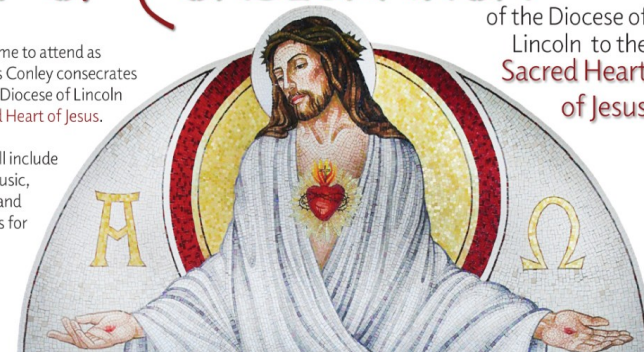
PARISH COUNCIL STRAW VOTE
